








Indiana Donor Network Shawl Making Recommendations

Each person crochets or knits differently; therefore, the size, amount of yarn and finished products will vary based on the individual. The style, stitch used, and tension will determine how much yarn is required to meet the size requirements.

Specifications:

- Shawls must be rectangular in shape.
- Shawls should measure between 24" – 34" wide and 65" – 70" long.
- Yarn must be 100% acrylic (no wool).
- Wash shawls in non-scented detergent before sending them in to Indiana Donor Network.

How much approximate yarn do you need?

	Basix – 7 oz. – 359 yds. Crochet – 3 skeins Knit – 4 skeins
	Just Yarn Ombre – 9.8 oz. – 612 yds. Crochet - 2 skeins (may need 1 skein of Basix also) Knit – 2 skeins + 1 skein complementary color Basix
	Basix Shimmer – 4.23 oz. – 216 yds. Crochet – 6 skeins Knit – 8 skeins
	Basix Tweeds and Marls – 5 oz. – 245 yds. Crochet – 4+ skeins (may want to use complementary color) Knit – 5+ skeins (may want to use complementary color)
	Basix Trendy – 5 oz. – 250 yds. Crochet – 4+ skeins (may want to use complementary color) Knit – 5+ skeins (may want to use complementary color)
	Basix Mosaic – 4.23 oz – 216 yds. Crochet – 6 skeins (works well with complementary colors) Knit – 8 skeins (works well with complementary colors)
	Basix Multi – 5 oz. – 250 yds. Crochet – 4+ skeins (may want to use complementary color) Knit – 5+ skeins (may want to use complementary color)
